- Recycling and development of post-industrial waste to divert as much waste from landfills

- The marketing of vinyl backed ThermoFlex, which other than offering superior protection for the floors, also reduces the excessive consumption of PVC (post-industrial waste)
- The marketing of several high-performance mats with a longer life span (less usage) and less use of chemicals used to clean floors
